

LESSON PLAN FOR Security Awareness Training**Relevant regulations:**

STCW 78 as amended 2010 A VI/6.1-3

Required competence:

- Contribute to the enhancement of maritime security through heightened awareness
- Recognition of security threats
- Understanding of the need for and methods of maintaining security awareness and vigilance

Mandatory for:

All seafarers employed or engaged in any capacity on board a ship which is required to comply with the provisions of the ISPS Code without designated security duties

Where to do it:

The training course can either be attended at a training institute or on board of a ship. This training is approved by the Netherlands Shipping Inspectorate (ILT).

Certification/evidence required:

At the end of the course there will be evidence that the participating seafarers have completed an approved Security Awareness training. ROODBOVENGROEN is authorised by ILT to issue a Certificate to the participants who have successfully completed the course.

Required course items for institute:

- Lesson room ashore or on board
- Beamer, Laptop and screen
- Trainer with maritime background and involved in security matters on board

Required course items for students:

- Pen and paper
- Hand-out from ROODBOVENGROEN

Maximum number of students: 24

Amount of Lesson hours:

- 4 hours of theoretical training and scenario training (practical lessons). During the entire time evaluation takes place based on the level of participation and transferred knowledge / awareness of the students. Each part of the course allows for questions and feedback.
